



Truitt Middle School
Retest/Redo Policy
2017-2018



In accordance with state and local guidelines, students at Truitt Middle School are permitted to retest/redo according to the following:

Checking for Understanding:

After an assignment is turned in and graded:

- A student may redo at least one daily grade or class assignment (Checking for Understanding) for which he/she earned a failing grade (a grade below a 70).
 - The highest grade a student can earn on a redone assignment will be a 70. A student may not earn a grade lower than the original grade.

Relevant Application:

- A student will have at least one opportunity each grading period to redo a Relevant Application for which he/she earned a failing grade (a grade below 70).
 - The highest grade a student can earn on a redone assignment will be a 70. A student may not earn a grade lower than the original grade.

Summative Assessments:

- A student will have one opportunity each grading period to retake a test (Summative Assessment) for which he/she earned a failing grade (a grade below a 70).
 - The highest grade a student can earn on a test retake will be a 70. A student may not earn a grade lower than the original grade.
 - Prior to retesting, the teacher may require an intervening action (tutorial attendance, student group, test correction, etc.).
 - District Progress Monitoring (DPM) and benchmark exams are not included in the retest opportunity.

Grades assigned/earned within a grading period must be posted within the same grading period. Grading closes at the end of the grading period.
